



Guide for funeral and memorial services

Planning Funeral Services

Contact with your preferred funeral home and St. Anne's Chaplain allows for the coordination of funeral and memorial services. St. Anne's Salvatorian Campus considers it an honor to celebrate resident funeral services in our chapel, and welcomes family members to plan liturgical services with our Chaplain. In preference to accommodate facility schedule, funeral services are generally arranged between 9 a.m. and 2 p.m.

Eulogies

Eulogies during a funeral celebration express love and remembrance of your loved one. Reading shared memories may be planned when making funeral service arrangements.

Gravesite Blessing

If desired, arrangements for St. Anne's Chaplain to accompany your family to the cemetery to offer gravesite blessings can be made when planning funeral services.

Catering Services

St. Anne's offers catering services in our Gathering Room following a funeral. The Gathering Room is reserved based on availability. Catering services are arranged with our Dietary Services Department when planning a funeral. Our Director of Food Services will discuss menu options, guest counts, costs and any questions you may have.

Parking

St. Anne's Chapel and Gathering Room are located on street level with ample parking for easy access without stairs. There is no fee for parking.

Please reserve plant stands, memory boards and easels with your funeral home. Tables are available upon request through our Pastoral Department.
